Main Street Minute

A lot of exciting things are happening with the Historic Tacony Revitalization Project and the revitalization of Torresdale Avenue. Here at the Tacony CDC we have completed two of our storefront improvement projects. You may have seen the outstanding new storefronts at both DeNofa's Deli and the Sannutti Funeral Home. Construction is currently underway on 12 more storefronts along Torresdale Avenue. This work will include painting, new signage, façade cleaning, and awning installation.

This is funded in partnership with the City of Philadelphia Commerce Department Storefront Improvement Program. Be sure to look for the new banners and selected sidewalk improvements coming this fall along the Avenue. Look for twenty new trees on the 6300-6800 blocks of Torresdale Avenue in partnership with TreePhilly.

Also arriving will be new security cameras under the Commerce Department SafeCam Program. This grant program provides business owners with a reimbursement grant of 50% of the cost of qualifying new camera systems.

Commercial vacancy on Torresdale Avenue has also declined, and we will be welcoming a new business, Pagano's Steaks and Shakes to the corner of Torresdale Avenue and Robbins Avenue. This is the former Produce City location which has been vacant for more than two years. Construction is currently underway at the corner of Disston St and Torresdale Avenue, the former vacant lot and site of the PGW explosion. This new infill building is designed to complement our historic buildings and strengthen our commercial corridor.

I hope you will join us in recognizing this progress. We have launched our membership program "Support Tacony."
