Historical Society News

The final report of the comprehensive Survey of Historic Resources was received by the Historical Society of Tacony from the consultants at Preservation Design Partnership, LLC within the past week. Over 1,500 properties in the Disston Estate were photographed and cataloged as part of this study, which concluded that the streetscapes within the area retain the sense of scale, rhythm, forms, volumes and predominance of building materials of a historic neighborhood. A unifying factor is the relatively narrow range of scales and sizes of lots, regardless of housing type, creating a sense of proportionality between open space and buildings which unifies the Disston Estate. It was determined that this central portion of Tacony retains the integrity of location, design, materials, feeling and association, with a greater story of industrial paternalism, which warrants significance as a designated historic area.

In 2014 we will proceed with the National Historic District Register nomination for the Disston Estate, which is handled at the state level through the Pennsylvania Historic and Museum Commission. The nomination to the Philadelphia Historical Commission for the local district will follow the national nomination but will likely be proposed in the form of a condensed section of the Disston Estate or select portions of the Estate where loss of architectural character is not a significant factor.

When weather permits there will be eight (8) more historic house plaques installed at homes within the "pilot" area of the program (6900-7000 Tulip/Keystone, 6900 Hegerman, 4800-4900 Tyson/Disston/Longshore) bringing the total to twenty-three (23) plaques desribing the date and for whom each home was built. This was made possible with a 50% buy-in from the homeowners and grant funds provided through the Preservation Alliance for Greater Philadelphia and the Philadelphia Activities Fund. Future phases of the program will be implemented as grant funds are secured, and eligibility will be open to all homeowners within the Disston Estate. We hope to develop a series of walking tours in the spring and summer to highlight the plaques/homes of some of Tacony's pioneers and also include the History of Tacony mural and new Engine 38 firehouse.
